CHAP. 168

Chapter 168.

Resolve in Aid of Navigation on Sebago Lake.

Sebago lake,
in aid of
naviga-
tion on.

Resolved, that the sum of four hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and the erection of lights in Sebago lake and the maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, and the sum of three hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and the erection of lights in Sebago lake and the maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen. Said buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in said Sebago lake as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon. All said moneys shall be expended under the direction of the state steamboat inspectors; and any part of the money hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of lights which shall be unexpended at the end of the year nineteen hundred and fourteen shall revert back to the state.

Chapter 169.

Resolve, Reimbursing the Town of Milo for Money Expended for the Support of Certain State Paupers.

Resolved, that the sum of three hundred and forty-three dollars and seventy-eight cents (\$343.78) be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the town of Milo, to reimburse the said town for its expenses in supporting Mary Lovering and her three minor children, family of Frank A. Lovering, state paupers.

Chapter 170.

Resolve, Providing for Aid in the Payment of Premiums Awarded by the Maine State Agricultural Society and Also Repealing Certain Resolves in Favor of Said Society.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby annually appropriated the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars for the Maine State Agricultural Society, provided that the said society shall annually appropriate and award an amount equal to the sum hereby appropriated, and pay the same in premiums for stock, dairy, agricultural and industrial products. Said society may draw said appropriation upon its vouchers that such amount has been paid out for strictly stock, dairy, agricultural and

industrial purposes. Chapter one hundred ninety-four of the resolves of eighteen hundred ninety-three as amended by chapter one hundred fifty-five of the resolves of nineteen hundred and five and so much of chapter one hundred and sixty, of the resolves of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine as pertains to the Maine State Agricultural Society, are hereby repealed.

Chapter 171.

Resolve, Reimbursing the Town of Hermon for Money Expended for the Support of a State Pauper.

Resolved, that the sum of forty-six dollars be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the town of Hermon, to reimburse said town for the amount expended for the support of Mrs. Erick Nelson, a state pauper.

Chapter 172.

Resolve, Authorizing the State Treasurer to Procure a Temporary Loan for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Fourteen.

Resolved, that to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be and is hereby authorized to procure on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year nineteen hundred and fourteen, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be needed.

That the treasurer of state be and hereby is authorized to give notes in behalf of the state, payable within three years from the date hereof, for such portions of the loan hereby authorized as may be required.

That in pursuance of this resolve, the treasurer of state is authorized, from time to time, as may be necessary and advisable to renew said loans and to sign renewal notes for the same.
