And the state treasurer is hereby directed to charge the amounts of said bills to the general legislative expense account, and to file a copy of this resolve with the committee on appropriations and financial affairs.

Resolve, for Retracing and Defining the Lines Around the Reserved or School Lands of Plantations and Townships.

Resolved, that for the purpose of retracing and defining the lines around the reserved lots or school lands of plantations and townships there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen and the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.

Chapter 215.

Resolve, Providing for an Appropriation for Control of Contagious Diseases Among Domestic Animals.

Resolved, that the sum of fifty thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, and the same sum for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen, be and hereby is appropriated to be used under the direction of the live stock sanitary commissioner for the control of contagious diseases among domestic animals.
