There is hereby appropriated the sum of nine hundred dollars (\$900) for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, and the sum of nine hundred dollars (\$900) for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen for the purposes of said contract; provided, however, that this appropriation shall lapse in case the books are not delivered on the dates specified herein.

**Chapter 221.**

Resolve for Laying the County Taxes for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen.

Whereas, the appropriations called for in this resolve are immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety, and in the opinion of this legislature constitute an emergency as contemplated by the constitution, be it therefore

Preamble.

Resolved, that the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purpose of law, for the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen:
