CHAP. 250

Resolve, in Favor of the Maine Mission for the Deaf for Maintenance.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two hundred dollars to be paid to the Maine Mission for the Deaf at Belfast, for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen and two hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen, for maintenance.
