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**Chapter 302.****CHAP. 302**

**Chapter 303.**

Resolve in Favor of Marlon B. Holway, Stenographer to the Recording Officer of the Senate.

Resolved, that the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars be and is hereby appropriated to be paid to Marion B. Holway of Machiasport, for services as stenographer and typist, to the secretary of the senate; said services being rendered in the preparation of the journal of the senate, and to be rendered in the preparation of the index of said journal.

**Chapter 304.**

Resolve, Providing for an Epidemic or Emergency Fund for the Year Nineteen Hundred Fourteen.

Resolved, that the sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen is hereby appropriated as an epidemic or emergency fund to be used, if necessary, by the state board of health with the consent of the governor and council in case of the invasion or threatened invasion of small-pox or other dangerous epidemic disease into the state, and the governor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant for the same, or such part of the same as may be needed, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
