#### Chapter 132.

An Act to Amend Section Two of Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to Ice Fishing in Lower Kezar Pond, in the Town of Fryeburg, in Oxford County, and in the Town of Bridgton, in Cumberland County,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised May catch pickerel and tatutes, as amended by chapter two hundred six of the black bass Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, as prohibits fishing through the ice for pickerel and black bass, in accordance with the general law of the State relating to ice fishing, in Lower Kezar pond, in the town of Fryeburg, in Oxford county, and in the town of Bridgton, in Cumberland county, is hereby repealed.

#### Chapter 133.

An Act Additional to Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to the Use of Firearms upon Megunticook Lake and Adjacent Waters and Tributaries Thereof, in Knox and Waldo Counties, and upon the Shores Thereof.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The use of firearms is hereby prohibited from Use of firethe first day of April of each year to the thirtieth day of September following, both days inclusive, upon the waters of Megunticook lake, formerly called Canaan lake, and its tributary lakes, ponds and streams, and upon the land bordering on the same included within the following roads: Beginning at Hopkins' Corner, so-called, in the town of Camden; thence via the Turnpike road, so-called, to Lincolnville Center; thence to Wiley's Corner in Lincolnville; thence to the Mansfield school house in the town of Camden; thence via the fish hatchery to place of beginning. All of said lake, its tributaries and shores being located in the towns of Camden, Lincolnville and \_location. Hope, in the counties of Knox and Waldo.

CHAP. 134 --penalty.

134 Section 2. Whoever violates any provision of section one of  $\frac{1}{2}$  this act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense.

#### Chapter 134.

An Act to Amend Section Two of Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to Fishing in the Davis Ponds, in Guilford and Willimantic, in the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, as prohibits fishing through the ice in the four Davis ponds, so-called, in Guilford and Willimantic, in the county of Piscataquis, in accordance with the general law of the State, relating to ice fishing, is hereby repealed.

#### Chapter 135.

An Act Additional to Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to Fishing in Certain Waters in Oxford County.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time, in any of the tributaries to Aziscohos lake, or in any of the tributaries to Parmachenee lake, or in any of the tributaries to the Magalloway river above Aziscohos dam, all in the county of Oxford; nor shall any person fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish, at any time, in Aziscohos lake or in Parmachenee lake or in Long pond or in the Magalloway river above Aziscohos dam, or in Little Magalloway river below Wheeler dam, which waters are situated in township four, range five, W. B. K. P., otherwise called Oxbow town, township four, range six, W. B. K. P., otherwise called Bowmantown, township five, range five, W. B. K. P., otherwise called Parmachenee town, township five, range four, W. B. K. P., otherwise called Lynchtown, township five, range three, W. B. K. P., otherwise called Parkertown, and in Lincoln
