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**Chapter 72.**

CHAP. 72

An Act to Provide for the Care and Maintenance of the Mount Desert Bridge, in the Town of Trenton.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The towns of Eden, Mount Desert, Southwest Harbor, Tremont and Trenton, assisted by the county of Hancock, shall bear the expense of keeping the Mount Desert bridge in the town of Trenton in the county of Hancock, in repair and employing a draw tender. The cost of maintaining said bridge and employing a draw tender shall be borne by the county and towns as follows: The county of Hancock shall pay three hundred dollars annually; and the said towns shall pay the balance of the expense in the following proportions: Eden, five-tenths; Mount Desert, two-tenths; Southwest harbor, one-tenth; Tremont, one-tenth; Trenton, one-tenth. The amount so to be paid by each of said towns shall be computed and fixed by the county commissioners of said county, and said several amounts shall be added to, included in, and become and be a part of the county tax annually assessed against said towns.

Mount Desert toll bridge shall hereafter be supported by county and towns named herein.

Section 2. The county commissioners of said county shall have charge of said bridge and employ a suitable draw tender, and keep said bridge in repair.

—county commissioners shall have charge of bridge.

Section 3. This act shall take effect, in accordance with the constitution, whenever by purchase, gift or otherwise the said Mount Desert bridge is made a free bridge.

**Chapter 73.**

An Act to Amend Section Thirteen of Chapter One Hundred Twenty of the Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred Ninety-nine, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Thirty-three of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court in the Town of East Livermore.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section thirteen of chapter one hundred twenty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-nine, as amended by section one of chapter two hundred thirty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "four hundred" in the fourth and fifth lines of said amended section thirteen and inserting in place thereof the words 'six hundred' so that said section shall read as follows:

Ch. 120, Sec. 13, P. & S. Laws 1899, as amended, further amended.
