Section 2. The rights, powers and privileges of the Stratton Water Company, which were granted by chapter three hundred forty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred nine, are hereby revived and extended for two years from the date on which this act shall take effect. The persons named in the original act and those substituted by section one of this act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said original act, to be exercised in the same manner, and for the same purposes as specified in the said original act.

Chapter 90.

An Act to Extend the Charter of the Washburn Water Company,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the Washburn Water Company, which were granted by chapter thirty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, are hereby extended for two years from the time when this act shall take effect; and the persons named in said original act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said original act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified in said original act.

Charter ex-tended for two year period.

Chapter 91.

An Act to Extend the Charter of the Bluehill Water Company,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All the rights, powers and privileges of the Bluehill Water Company which were granted by chapter one hundred seventytwo of the Private and Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred thirteen, are hereby extended for and during the period of two years from the first day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred fifteen.
