Section 2. Any violation of this act shall be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than fifty dollars. CHAP. 127

Chapter 127.

An Act Authorizing the Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power Company, Limited, to Exercise Certain Powers within the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Maine and New Brunswick Electrical Power Company, Limited, a corporation created by and existing under the laws of the province of New Brunswick, is hereby authorized to sell electricity to any corporations, persons or firms authorized to distribute electricity in the towns of Washburn and Mapleton, in the county of Aroostook. For the purpose of carrying this act into effect said corporation is authorized to erect and maintain a line or lines of posts and wires with all necessary fixtures from its lines, as now existing, into and through the towns of Caribou, Presque Isle, Washburn and Mapleton.

Section 2. All locations upon streets, roads or ways necessary for the purpose of this act are hereby granted, and the municipal officers of said towns shall designate the streets, roads or ways, so to be occupied, as provided under the provisions of section seventeen of chapter fifty-five of the Revised Statutes.

—may extend line and sell power within State of Maine.

Municipal officers shall designate streets, etc., where line may be located.

Chapter 128.

An Act to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Eleven of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Eleven, Relating to The Congregational Conference and Missionary Society of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The second paragraph of section one, chapter two hundred eleven of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred eleven, is hereby amended by striking out the words "two hundred thousand dollars" in the seventh line, and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'five hundred thousand dollars,' so that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:
