Chapter 24.

Resolve Appropriating Money to Complete the Replanking of the Wiscasset Bridge,

Wiscasset Bridge, in favor of.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the year nineteen hundred fifteen the sum of six hundred fifty dollars to complete the replanking of the Wiscasset Bridge, so-called, between the towns of Wiscasset and Edgecomb, in the county of Lincoln; said sum to be expended under the direction of the State Highway Department.

Chapter 25.

Lester Patten, pension for. Resolve Providing a State Pension for Lester Patten.

Resolved, That there be paid to Lester Patten of Hermon a pension of twelve dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning with the first day of January, nineteen hundred fifteen, and continuing during the pleasure of the Legislature, and until otherwise ordered.

Chapter 26.

Resolve Providing a State Pension for Mary E. Elwell.

Mary E. Elwell, pension for.

Resolved, That there be paid to Mary E. Elwell of Chesterville, a state pension of ten dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen.

Chapter 27.

Resolve Providing an Increased State Pension for Salathiel D. Seeley.

Salathiel D. Seeley, increase in pension for. Resolved, That the sum of eight dollars per month be paid to Salathiel D. Seeley of Perry in the county of Washington, a veteran of the Civil war, payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen, in lieu of the pension of four dollars per month heretofore allowed him by the State.
