CHAP. 33 maintenance of the State Forest Nursery, in connection with the Department of Forestry, to supply forest tree seedlings at cost of production for use in planting the waste lands in the State of Maine.

Approved March 5, 1915.

Chapter 38.

Resolve Appropriating Money to Provide for Further Public Instruction in Forestry.

Instruction in forestry, in fayor of. Resolved, That the sum of five thousand dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, for the purpose of providing further public instruction in forestry; said fund to be administered in the manner provided by section sixty-five of chapter seven of the Revised Statutes.

Chapter 39.

Resolve in Favor of the Farmington State Normal School for the Purchase of Certain Land.

Farmington State Normal School, for land. Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Farmington State Normal School at Farmington the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen; said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trustees of the State Normal Schools for the purchase of certain land adjoining the property of said school.

Chapter 40.

Resolve in Favor of the Washington State Normal School at Machias for Completing and Furnishing the Partially Constructed Dormitory.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Washington State Normal School at Machias, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, said sum to be expended under the direction of the Trustees of the State Normal Schools for the completion of the partially constructed dormitory at said school and for furnishings for the same.
