Chapter 83.

Снар. 83

Resolve Reimbursing the Town of Perry for Money Expended on Account of a State Pauper.

Town of Perry, in favor of.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of ninety-five dollars and five cents for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Perry for money paid out on account of expenses of the last sickness and death of one George R. Cook, an alien and state pauper.

Approved March 10, 1915.

Chapter 84.

Resolve for General Maintenance of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell the sum of twenty-eight thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of thirty thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; both sums to be expended under the direction of the Trustees of juvenile institutions for the general maintenance of said school.

Chapter 85.

Resolve for the Permanent Improvement of Buildings and for Increasing the Water Supply at the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell, the sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen and the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended under the direction of the Trustees of juvenile institutions for the permanent improvement of buildings and increasing the water supply of said school.
