#### CHAP. 92

#### Chapter 92.

Resolve Providing a State Pension for Mary Allen.

Mary Allen, state pension for. Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one hundred ninety-two dollars per annum for each of the years nineteen hundred fifteen and nineteen hundred sixteen; the said sum for each of said years to be paid Mary Allen of Bowdoinham, in quarterly payments of forty-eight dollars each, under the supervision of the Governor and Council.

Approved March 15, 1915.

#### Chapter 93.

Resolve Providing a State Pension for Clarence M. Smith.

Clarence M. Smith, state pension for. Resolved, That there be paid to Clarence M. Smith of Norway, a pension of twelve dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen, and continuing during the pleasure of the Legislature and until otherwise ordered.

Approved March 15, 1915.

#### Chapter 94.

Resolve Providing a State Pension for Eliza E. Philbrook.

Eliza E. Philbrook, pension for. Resolved, That there be paid to Eliza E. Philbrook of Kittery, the sum of eight dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen.

Approved March 15, 1915.

#### Chapter 95.

Resolve Providing a State Pension for Alonzo J. Nevers.

Alonzo J. Nevers, state pension for, Resolved, That there be paid to Alonzo J. Nevers of Norway, a veteran of the Civil war, the sum of eight dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the funds appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen, and continuing during the pleasure of the Legislature.
