CHAP. 111

Chapter 111.

Resolve Appropriating Money to Aid in the Construction of a Road in the Town of Moscow.

Town of Moscow, in favor of road in.

—proviso.

—main-tenance of.

—State's share.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen to aid the town of Moscow in the construction of a road from the residence of Mrs. Delia McLaughlin to the Maine Central Railroad station at Dead Water, all in the town of Moscow, provided said town of Moscow appropriates the like sum of one thousand dollars for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the State Highway Department, and further provided that this Resolve shall be void and of no effect unless said town in accepting this appropriation, thereby and in consideration thereof, shall undertake that all road material, including clay, gravel, sand and rock, necessary for the improvement contemplated by this Resolve shall be furnished without expense to the State, and that said town shall assume and pay all damages arising from the taking of land or from the change of grade, drainage or alignment deemed by the State Highway Commission as necessary for said improvement. Said way when so improved shall be thereafter continually maintained, under the direction and control of said commission, at the joint expense of the State and said town; the charge against said town for maintenance of said way shall not exceed fifty per centum of the actual cost of such maintenance, nor an average of thirty dollars per mile per annum; and the payment by said town of its said share of said maintenance shall be enforced in the same manner as provided in sections ten and twenty-five of chapter one hundred thirty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen. The share of the State in said maintenance shall be paid out of the fund for administration and maintenance created by virtue of section thirty-three of said chapter one hundred thirty.

Chapter 112.

Resolve Appropriating Money to Aid in Improving a Highway in Caratunk Plantation.

Plantation of Caratunk, in favor of highway in.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen to aid Caratunk Plantation in improving the road in said Caratunk, commonly known as the Pleasant Pond road leading from

the store of Albert Clark on the main River road in Caratunk village to the hotel of James Martin on the shore of Pleasant pond, provided said Caratunk plantation appropriates the like sum of five hundred dollars for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the State Highway Department, and further provided that this Resolve shall be void and of no effect unless said town in accepting this appropriation, thereby and in consideration thereof, shall undertake that all road material, including clay, gravel, sand and rock, necessary for the improvement contemplated by this Resolve shall be furnished without expense to the State, and that said town shall assume and pay all damages whatsoever arising from the taking of land or from the change of grade, drainage or alignment, deemed by the State Highway Commission as necessary for said improvement. Said way when so improved shall be thereafter continually maintained under the direction and control of said commission at the joint expense of the State and said town; the charge against said town for maintenance of said way shall not exceed fifty per centum of the actual cost of such maintenance, nor an average of thirty dollars per mile per annum; and the payment by said town of its said share of said maintenance shall be enforced in the same manner as provided by sections ten and twenty-five of chapter one hundred thirty of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen. The share of the State in said maintenance shall be paid out of the fund for administration and maintenance created by virtue of section thirty-three of said chapter one hundred thirty.

Chapter 113.

Resolve Appropriating Money to Aid in Repairing and Altering the River Road in Pleasant Ridge Plantation in the County of Somerset.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen to aid Pleasant Ridge plantation in Somerset County in the repair and alteration of that part of the River road, so-called, in said plantation known as the John Rowe ledge, provided said Pleasant Ridge plantation appropriates a like sum of one thousand dollars for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the State Highway Department, and further provided that this Resolve shall be void and of no effect unless said town in accepting this appropriation thereby and in

Pleasant Ridge Plantation, in favor of River road in.
