Chapter 127.

CHAP. 127

Resolve Providing a State Pension for George N. Holland.

Resolved, That there be paid to George N. Holland of Hampden, a pension of fifteen dollars per month, payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, one thousand nine hundred fifteen and continuing during the pleasure of the Legislature and until otherwise ordered.

Chapter 128.

Resolve Authorizing the State Treasurer to Procure a Temporary Loan for the Year Nineteen Hundred Fifteen.

Resolved, That to provide for the wants of the Treasury, the Treasurer of State be, and hereby is, authorized to procure on the faith of the State, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year nineteen hundred fifteen, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be needed. That the Treasurer of State be, and hereby is, authorized to give notes in behalf of the State, payable within three years from the date thereof, for such portions of the loan hereby authorized as may be required. That in pursuance of this Resolve, the Treasurer of State be, and hereby is, authorized, from time to time, as may be necessary and advisable to renew said loans and to sign renewal notes for the same.

Chapter 129.

Resolve Authorizing the State Treasurer to Procure a Temporary Loan for the Year Nineteen Hundred Sixteen.

Resolved, That to provide for the wants of the Treasury, the Treasurer of State be, and hereby is, authorized to procure on the faith of the State, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year nineteen hundred sixteen, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be needed. That the Treasurer of State be, and hereby is, authorized to give notes in behalf of the State, payable within three years from the date thereof, for such portions of the loan here-
