CHAP. 135

Chapter 135.

Resolve in Favor of the Maine School for the Deaf for Maintenance and the Payment of Running Expenses, Also for the Purchase of Land and Building for a Girls' Dormitory and Hospital.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid the Maine School for the Deaf the sum of twenty-eight thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of twenty-eight thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; both of said sums to be expended for maintenance and the payment of running expenses.

And be it further Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the said school, the sum of twelve thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen for the purchase of land and buildings for a girls' dormitory and hospital.

Chapter 136.

Resolve in Favor of the Madawaska Training School for the Construction and Furnishing of a Suitable Dormitory Building.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Madawaska Training School at Fort Kent the sum of eight thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of eight thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended under the direction of the Trustees of the State Normal Schools for the construction of a suitable dormitory building at said school and for furnishings for the same.

Chapter 137.

Resolve Appropriating Money for the Publication and Circulation of a School Text in Civics, Local Geography and Local History.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated to defray the expenses of the publication and circulation among the teachers of public elementary and secondary schools of a suitable guide to the study of the elements of civics, local geography and local history, said guide to be used as a text book for the instruction of the youth of the State in the said subjects. The said sum shall be expended under the direction of the State Superintendent of Public Schools.
