Chapter 168.

CHAP. 168

Resolve in Favor of Alfred Yankauer for Services Rendered in Supplying the Attorney General with Information Regarding Certain Estates Liable to Pay Inheritance Taxes.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred fifteen dollars and ninety-nine cents be, and the same hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Alfred Yankauer, in payment for services rendered to the State of Maine in reporting to the Attorney General information relative to certain estates liable to pay inheritance taxes to the State of Maine, and in which estates the taxes have been determined and paid; together with interest at six per centum per annum from the time of such payments.

Chapter 169.

Resolve Providing a State Pension for Henry Golding.

Resolved, That Henry Golding of Gray be, and hereby is, granted a pension of twelve dollars per month, payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen, and continuing during the pleasure of the Legislature.

Approved March 24, 1915.

Chapter 170.

Resolve in Favor of Anson Academy for Certain Improvements and Repairs.

Resolved, That the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the Trustees of Anson Academy for the purpose of installing a heating plant, water supply, plumbing, toilets, and sewer, and making other necessary repairs and additions to the Anson Academy building at North Anson.
