Hiram Darling, a veteran of the Civil war, payable quarterly CHAP. 207 from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen.

Approved March 24, 1915.

Chapter 207.

Resolve in Favor of Westbrook Seminary for the Payment of a Certain Debt and for Furnishings for Alumni Hall.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, to be paid to Westbrook Seminary for the payment of the debt on the construction of a dormitory, and should there be any unexpended balance, the same may be used for furnishings for Alumni hall at said dormitory; said sums to be expended and used under the supervision of the Board of Trustees of said institution.

Approved March 24, 1915.

Chapter 208.

Resolve in Favor of North Yarmouth Academy for Repairs and Improvements, and Also for the Payment of Certain Indebtedness.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the year nineteen hundred fifteen the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred sixteen the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars to be paid to the Trustees of North Yarmouth Academy and by them expended for the repair and improvement of the buildings, fixtures and grounds of said institution and the payment of its indebtedness of four hundred dollars contracted in the year nineteen hundred fourteen for the repair of buildings.

Chapter 209.

Resolve in Favor of the Aroostook Central Institute for the Payment of Liabilities, and Also for Repairs and Improvements.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hun-
