Chapter 210.

Resolve in Favor of Higgins Classical Institute for Building Purposes.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen and the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, to be paid to the Trustees of Higguns Classical Institute at Charleston, for building purposes.

Chapter 211.

Resolve in Favor of the Ricker Classical Institute, for the Repair and Improvement of Buildings.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, the sum of five hundred dollars and for the year nineteen hundred sixteen the sum of five hundred dollars; to be paid to the Trustees of the Ricker Classical Institute at Houlton and by them expended for the repair and improvement of the buildings and fixtures of said institution.

Chapter 212.

Resolve in Favor of Lee Academy for Liquidation of Certain Indebtedness.

Lee Academy, in favor of.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, to be expended by the Trustees of Lee Academy in the liquidation of the indebtedness incurred in building the addition to the dormitory of said institution.
