Maine Nineteen Hundred Twenty Legislative Committee, whose duty shall be to confer with the State Board of Trade Nineteen Hundred Twenty Committee with a view of devising a plan for a celebration by the State of the one hundredth anniversary of the admission of the State of Maine to the Union and the three hundredth anniversary of the landing of the Pilgrims.

Approved March 25, 1915.

Chapter 242.

Resolve in Aid of Navigation on Sebago Lake, Songo River, Bay of Naples and Long Lake.

Sebago lake, Songo river, etc., in favor of buoys and lights upon.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated for the placing of buoys and the erection of lights in Sebago lake, Songo river, Bay of Naples and Long lake, and the maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and the erection of lights in Sebago lake, Songo river, Bay of Naples and Long lake, and the maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred sixteen. Said buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in said Sebago lake, Songo river, Bay of Naples and Long lake as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon. All said moneys shall be expended under the direction of the State Steamboat Inspectors; and any part of the money hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of lights which shall be unexpended at the end of the vear nineteen hundred sixteen shall revert back to the State.

Chapter 243.

Resolve Reimbursing The Forks Plantation for Money Expended on Account of a Certain State Pauper.

The Forks Plantation, in favor of. Resolved, That the sum of one hundred fifty-two dollars and fifty-seven cents be, and hereby is, appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the plantation of The Forks for money expended on account of Oscar Isaacson, a state pauper; and that the State Treasurer be, and hereby is, authorized to pay and deliver said sum of one hundred fifty-two dollars and fifty-seven cents to the treasurer of said The Forks plantation.
