Chapter 267.

CHAP. 267

Resolve in Favor of the Temporary Home for Women and Children for Maintenance.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen and the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, to be paid to the Temporary Home for Women and Children at Portland for maintenance.
