Chapter 293.

Chap. 293

Fort William Henry,

in favor of.

Resolve Appropriating Money for the Care and Maintenance of Fort William Henry in the Town of Bristol.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the care and maintenance of the memorial tower erected by the State at Fort William Henry, and for the preservation and improvement of the property of the State at said fort, the sum of six hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of three hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended under the direction of the Commissioners of the State in charge of said fort.

Approved March 31, 1915.

Chapter 294.

Resolve Appropriating Money to Reimburse the City of Biddeford for Money Expended for the Support of a Certain State Pauper,

Resolved, That the sum of nine hundred thirty-six dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid by the Treasurer of the State to the city of Biddeford, out of moneys of the State not otherwise appropriated, for money expended by the said city of Biddeford, for the care and support of Cyrille Nolette, a state pauper; provided, however, that said sum shall be paid only on vouchers produced by said city of Biddeford and approved by the Governor and Council.

Chapter 295.

Resolve Reimbursing the City of Biddeford for Money Expended for the Support of Certain State Paupers.

Resolved, That the sum of seven hundred forty-two dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid by the Treasurer of the State to the city of Biddeford, out of moneys of the State. not otherwise appropriated to reimburse said city of Biddeford for money expended for the care and support of William Landry of Biddeford, deceased, and his wife and family, during his lifetime, and for the support of Leocadie Landry, widow of the said William Landry, and the children of the said William Landry, and the children of the said William Landry.

Biddeford reimbursed for money expended on pauper account.
