Chapter 387.

Resolve Authorizing the Governor and Council to Use Any Unexpended Balance in the Treasury for Construction of One or More Buildings for the Care of Inmates at the School for Feeble Minded at Pownal.

Resolved, That the Governor and Council are hereby authorized to use any unexpended balance in the Treasury, such sum of money not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars as they may deem necessary for the erection of any building or buildings for the care of inmates at the State School for Feeble Minded at Pownal.
