PUBLIC LAWS

Chapter 1.

An Act to Repeal Chapter Two Hundred and Eighty-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to the Keeping and Sale of Dynamite, Powder and Other Explosives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1917, c. 288; relating to explosives, repealed. Chapter two hundred and eighty-eight of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby repealed.

Approved February 7, 1919.

Chapter 2.

An Act to Amend Chapter Eight of the Revised Statutes by Repealing Sections Thirty, Thirty-one, Thirty-two and Thirty-three, Relating to the Control of Forest Fires.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 8, §§ 30, 31, 32 and 33; relating to forest commissioner and preservation of forests, repealed. Sections thirty, thirty-one, thirty-two, and thirty-three of chapter eight of the revised statutes are hereby repealed.
