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CHAP. 24

Chapter 24.

 An Act to Amend Chapter Two Hundred and Eighty-seven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1917, c. 287; relating to issuance of automobile plates by secretary of state, amended. Chapter two hundred and eighty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said chapter and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 42. Pleasure plates from two to three thousand and truck plates one to five hundred for following year to be reserved for present holders until December first. Whenever any person has once registered a motor vehicle, of which he is the owner, under the provisions of this chapter, the secretary of state shall, at the request of the person owning a motor vehicle so registered, allow such person to keep and use the same number plates for the entire calendar year for which the plates were issued, provided such person complies with the other provisions of the motor vehicle law. The secretary of state shall reserve until December first of each year the same registration number for the succeeding year for persons having registration numbers two to three thousand for pleasure vehicles, and numbers one to five hundred for commercial vehicles, if such person shall, previous to the first day of December of the current year, pay for the registration of his motor vehicle for the succeeding year and otherwise comply with the provisions of the motor vehicle law.'

Chapter 25.

An Act to Amend Chapter Two Hundred and Sixty-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Dental Hygienists. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1917, c. 268, § 2; relating to examination and qualification of dental hygienists, amended. Section two of chapter two hundred and sixty-eight of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby amended by inserting after the word "examination" in the tenth line thereof the following: 'which certificate shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in the room or rooms in which she practices' and by adding at the end of said section the following: 'Said certificate shall be considered a license to practice as a dental hygienist in this state, except that it shall be unlawful for any person to practice as a dental hygienist in this state in any year after the year in which said certificate is issued to her unless she shall pay to the treasurer of the state board of dental examiners on or before January first of said year a fee of one dollar for which she shall

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
