Supplementary to Public Laws of the Regular Session

Chapter 240.

An Act to Repeal Chapter Fourteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, Relating to the Acknowledgment of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1919, c. 14, relating to acknowledgment of deeds outside of state, requiring authentication of authority of notary, repealed. Chapter fourteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen is hereby repealed.
