CHAP. 14

and ten of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, is hereby extended for two years from the date when this act becomes effective with the same force and effect in all respects as if said incorporation were hereby granted.

Chapter 14.

An Act to Extend the Charter of the Lincoln County Street Railway. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Charter of Lincoln County Street Railway extended. The time within which the Lincoln County Street Railway, a corporation organized under the general laws of the state, shall actually commence business under its charter, is hereby extended two years from the date when this act takes effect.
- Sec. 2. Existing statutes and rights not affected. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal or shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part of any existing statute, and all the rights and duties herein mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof and additional thereto.

Chapter 15.

An Act to Ratify, Confirm and Make Valid the Doings of the Congregational Parish in Abbot Village, and of the Abbot Village Congregational Church, and Authorizing Them to Unite.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 7. Proceedings, gifts, conveyances, etc., ratified and made valid. All corporate acts and proceedings of the Congregational Parish in Abbot Village, and all corporate acts and proceedings of the Abbot Village Congregational Church, all gifts, grants, bequests and donations made to it, and all grants and conveyances made by it, are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.
- Sec. 2. Union authorized. The said Congregational Parish in Abbot Village is hereby empowered and authorized to unite with the said Congregational Church in Abbot Village as a duly incorporated body under the title of the Abbot Village Congregational Church whenever, at a duly called meeting of the said parish, two-thirds of the members present and voting shall declare themselves in favor of such union.
