Chapter 19

An Act to Change the Name of Whetstone Pond in Abbot and Blanchard in the County of Piscataquis to Sylvan Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Name of Whetstone pond changed to Sylvan lake. The name of the pond known as Whetstone pond, the same being situated in the towns of Abbot and Blanchard, in the county of Piscataquis, is hereby changed to Sylvan lake.

Sec. 2. Inconsistent acts repealed. All acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Chapter 20.

An Act Additional to Chapter Three Hundred and Forty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred and Sixty-four, Entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Officers and Members of Monument Lodge."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authorized to hold property to amount of \$200,000 in excess of that previously authorized. Monument Lodge, incorporated under chapter three hundred and forty-nine of the private and special laws of Maine, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-four, may acquire and hold real and personal property, and the income thereof, to the amount of two hundred thousand dollars in excess of that now authorized, with power to buy, sell, mortgage, lease and rent the same for business purposes and for purposes of investment.

Chapter 21.

An Act to Extend the Provisions of Chapter Two Hundred and Fourteen of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen, as Extended by Chapter Fifty of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Authorizing the Town of Lisbon to Supply Gas and Electricity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Authority extended for additional period of two years. Chapter two hundred and fourteen of the private and special laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, as extended by chapter fifty of the private and special laws of one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, is hereby continued in force, and the incorporators named therein are hereby given a further period of two years from the time this act shall take effect in which to organize and commence business under this act.
