Chapter 35.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for Further Maintenance of the State Forest Nursery.

State forest nursery. Resolved: That the sum of one thousand dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, to be expended by the forest commissioner for the maintenance of the state forest nursery, or for establishing auxiliary nurseries; and for encouraging in any practical way the reforesting of waste or cut over lands in Maine.

Chapter 36.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for Continuance of White Pine Blister Rust Control.

White pine blister rust, control of. Resolved: That the sum of five thousand dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, and the sum of five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, for the purpose of controlling and eradicating the white pine blister rust in the State of Maine, as authorized by senate bill number one hundred and seventy-one as passed by the seventyeighth legislature, nineteen hundred and seventeen, entitled "An Act Providing for the Control of the White Pine Blister Rust and Other Fungous and Insect Pests."

Chapter 37.

Resolve, Providing for the Completion of the Book of Plans of Waldo County and Appropriating Money therefor.

Waldo county book of plans. Resolved: That the state land agent be, and hereby is, instructed to cause the book of plans of Waldo county to be completed by adding to the plans already in said book such plans in the Massachusetts archives as have not already been copied, and by having all copies certified by the secretary of state for Massachusetts, after which said book shall be forwarded to the register of deeds for said county of Waldo, and the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, or such part of that sum as may be necessary, hereby is appropriated to pay the expense of such completion.
