Emergency. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 59.

Resolve, Providing for a State Pension for Mrs. Alfred Polk of Lewiston.

Mrs. Alfred Polk, Lewiston, state pension. Resolved: That there be paid to Mrs. Alfred Polk of Lewiston, in the county of Androscoggin and State of Maine, the sum of eight dollars per month, payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred and nineteen and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature.

Chapter 60.

Resolve, in Favor of Benjamin H. Varney, Secretary of the Committee on Education.

Benjamin H. Varney, legislative committee on education, expenses. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Benjamin H. Varney, secretary of the committee on education, the sum of two hundred dollars and eight cents for expenses of said committee incurred in visiting the University of Maine and state normal schools.
