#### Chapter 83.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for Payment of Damages Arising out of Death of Edgar Chase Harnden.

Edgar Chase Harnden, payment of claims arising from death of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of four hundred and fifty-seven dollars and twelve cents for the purpose of paying the following bills, in settlement of all claims arising out of death of Edgar Chase Harnden, an employee of the State Highway Commission:

#### Chapter 84.

Resolve, Reimbursing Plantations because of Reduction in the Rate of Interest Paid by the State to Plantations on their Wild Land School Funds.

Interest on school fund, reimbursing certain plantations on account of reduction in interest. Resolved: That the plantations named on the following list be paid the amounts set opposite their respective names and that the said several sums of money represented by said amounts be, and hereby are, appropriated for said purpose, to cover period from July first, nineteen hundred and seventeen, to December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighteen:
