Chapter 94.

Resolve, in Favor of the Maine School for the Deaf.

Maine School for the Deaf, maintenance. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Maine School for the Deaf, the sum of thirty thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, and the sum of thirty thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, for the following purposes:

Resolve, in Favor of the State Tuberculosis Sanatoriums for Maintenance and other Purposes for the Years Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen and Nineteen Hundred and Twenty.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, which may remain unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for expenditure during the year nineteen hundred and twenty, and provided further, that the expenditures of all of the sums above appropriated by, or under the control of, the trustees of said sanatoriums, shall be subject to the direction and approval of the governor and council, who may, by order, upon recommendation of the said trustees, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the above appropriations to meet the deficiencies for the same institution.

Chapter 96.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Committee on Insane Hospitals for Expenses to Bangor.

Legislative committee insane hospitals, expenses to Bangor. Resolved: That there be paid the sum of fifty-five dollars to the several members of the committee on insane hospitals, to reimburse said committee for money paid out on their trip to Bangor.

Resolve, to Reimburse the Committee on State Sanatoriums for Expenses to Hebron and Fairfield.

Legislative committee state sanatoriums, expenses to Hebron and Fairfield. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of sixty-three dollars and fifty-one cents to be paid to the several members of the committee on state sanatoriums to reimburse said committee for railroad fares and expenses on their trips to Hebron and Fairfield.
