Resolve, in Favor of the Provident Life & Trust Company of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for a Tax Credit.

Provident Life & Trust Company, tax credit. Resolved: That the Provident Life & Trust Company of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, be entitled to credit upon taxes due, or hereafter becoming due, from it to the State of Maine, in a sum equal to the total sums improperly assessed against said company on premium abatements and paid by it to the State of Maine for years as follows:

Resolve, in Favor of Certain Members of the Twenty-sixth Division.

Twenty-sixth Division, A. E. F., expenses of members of to Boston to participate in review. Whereas, the Twenty-sixth Division, A. E. F., is about to return from foreign service and disembark in the city of Boston, and

Whereas, a review of said Twenty-sixth Division is to be held before officials of the State of Maine in said Boston during the month of April, and

Whereas, many members of the Twenty-sixth Division are now in Maine

at their respective homes, in advance of the balance of the Division, including the peerless One Hundred and Third, so largely made up of the former Second Regiment, N. G. S. M., and

Whereas, an appropriation of money to make it possible for the state to assist in the celebration of the return of her heroes is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health and safety, now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sufficient sum of money to defray the traveling and incidental expenses of each returned member of the Twenty-sixth Division, A. E. F., from his residence to Boston and return, for the purpose of participating in the welcome and review of the Twenty-sixth Division, said money to be expended under the authority and direction of the adjutant general.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 132.

Resolve, in Favor of the Several State Normal Schools and the Madawaska Training School for Permanent Repairs and Improvement of Buildings.

Normal Schools and Madawaska Training School, repairs and improvement of buildings. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the several state normal schools, and the Madawaska Training School, the sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, and the sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of state normal schools as indicated in the following schedule:
