Whereas, an appropriation of money to make it possible for the state to assist in the celebration of the return of her heroes is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health and safety, now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sufficient sum of money to defray the traveling and incidental expenses of each returned member of the Twenty-sixth Division, A. E. F., from his residence to Boston and return, for the purpose of participating in the welcome and review of the Twenty-sixth Division, said money to be expended under the authority and direction of the adjutant general.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 132.

Resolve, in Favor of the Several State Normal Schools and the Madawaska Training School for Permanent Repairs and Improvement of Buildings.

Normal Schools and Madawaska Training School, repairs and improvement of buildings. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the several state normal schools, and the Madawaska Training School, the sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, and the sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of state normal schools as indicated in the following schedule:

Chapter 133.

Resolve, in Favor of the Bangor State Hospital for Purposes Herein Enumerated for the Years Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen and Nineteen Hundred and Twenty.

Bangor State Hospital, improvement of buildings, purchase of cows and installation of laundry machinery. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Bangor State Hospital:

For purchase and installation of laundry machinery for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars,	\$2,500
For the purchase of cows, the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, and renovation of barn, the sum of two thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen,	\$4,500
For finishing and equipping sleeping rooms for convalescent patients in attics of D and F buildings, for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of eighteen thousand dollars,	\$18,000

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen which may remain unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for expenditure during the year nineteen hundred and twenty, and provided further that the governor and council may, by order, upon the recommendation of the trustees of said institution, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropriations for the same institution.

Resolve, Making an Appropriation to Assist, Encourage and Develop the Poultry Industry in Maine.

Encouragement and development of poultry industry. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for
