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## CHAP. 133

**For the Year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty**

<b>Western State Normal School, Gorham, three thousand dollars</b>	<b>\$3,000</b>
<b>Farmington State Normal School, Farmington, three thousand dollars</b>	<b>\$3,000</b>
<b>Eastern State Normal School, Castine, fifteen hundred dollars</b>	<b>\$1,500</b>
<b>Washington State Normal School, Machias, one thousand dollars</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
<b>Aroostook State Normal School, Presque Isle, fifteen hundred dollars</b>	<b>\$1,500</b>
<b>Madawaska Training School, Fort Kent, twenty-five hundred dollars</b>	<b>\$2,500</b>

**Chapter 133.**

Resolve, in Favor of the Bangor State Hospital for Purposes Herein Enumerated for the Years Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen and Nineteen Hundred and Twenty.

**Bangor State Hospital, improvement of buildings, purchase of cows and installation of laundry machinery. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Bangor State Hospital:

<b>For purchase and installation of laundry machinery for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars,</b>	<b>\$2,500</b>
<b>For the purchase of cows, the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, and renovation of barn, the sum of two thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen,</b>	<b>\$4,500</b>
<b>For finishing and equipping sleeping rooms for convalescent patients in attics of D and F buildings, for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of eighteen thousand dollars,</b>	<b>\$18,000</b>

**Provided,** that any balance of the sums above appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen which may remain unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for expenditure during the year nineteen hundred and twenty, and provided further that the governor and council may, by order, upon the recommendation of the trustees of said institution, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropriations for the same institution.

**Chapter 134.**

Resolve, Making an Appropriation to Assist, Encourage and Develop the Poultry Industry in Maine.

**Encouragement and development of poultry industry. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for

the year one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty, to promote, encourage and develop the poultry industry of the state through the medium of poultry exhibition or shows. Such appropriation shall be expended under the direction of the commissioner of agriculture in consultation with one representative of each of the four poultry associations in the state holding an annual exhibition or show. Such portion of the appropriation to be awarded each year under the discretion of the commissioner of agriculture and representatives of these associations as above provided, the amount to be determined on the basis or the importance of the utility features, including utility laying competitions, utility breeding stock competitions, dressed poultry and egg competitions and any other features devised to promote the utility value and educational work of any poultry show. And the said commissioner is hereby authorized to employ such agents, assistants or experts as may be deemed practicable to carry out the provisions of this resolve.

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**Chapter 135.**

Resolve, in Favor of the Board of Veterinary Examiners.

**Veterinary examiners, expenses and services of board of. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of three hundred and one dollars and sixty-seven cents to be paid to the board of veterinary examiners, for services rendered and traveling expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

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**Chapter 136.**

Resolve, in Favor of Rangeley Lake, Mooselucmeguntic Lake, and Cupsuptic Lake, in Franklin and Oxford Counties.

**Rangeley, Mooselucmeguntic and Cupsuptic lakes, aid of navigation on. Resolved:** That there be paid the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, and three hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, for the aid of navigation on said lakes.
