shall be paid to the secretary of the senate a weekly payment of thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents, and balance at completion of the work. Said filing and indexing shall be under the supervision of the governor and council.

Chapter 157.

Resolve, in Favor of the Commissioners of Pharmacy of the State of Maine.

Commissioners of pharmacy, services and traveling expenses. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of sixteen hundred and eleven dollars to be paid to the commissioners of pharmacy, for services rendered and traveling expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
