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## Chapter 164.

Resolve, in Relation to the Celebration of the One Hundredth Anniversary of the Admission of Maine into the Union.

**Centennial observance of Maine's admission to the Union. Resolved:** That the governor and council and the joint special committee of the seventy-ninth legislature, appointed to arrange for the celebration of the one hundredth anniversary of the admission of Maine into the Union, be and are hereby directed to take such measures as to them may seem fitting to arrange for a proper observance and celebration of the said one hundredth anniversary.

Approved April 4, 1919.

## Chapter 166.

Resolve, Making an Appropriation for the Maine Seed Improvement Association.

**Maine Seed Improvement Association; promoting seed and crop improvement.** Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, to be paid to the Maine Seed Improvement Association; this amount to be used by said association for the purpose of promoting seed and crop improvement in the State of Maine, by holding an annual exhibition and meeting, at which premiums shall be paid upon seed, agricultural crops
