Chapter 182.

Resolve, on the Pay Roll of the Senate.

Pay Roll of the Senate. Resolved: That there be paid to the members and officers of the Senate of the Seventy-ninth Legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the Legislature convened on the thirty-first day of August, nineteen hundred twenty, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a Pay Roll list certified to the State Auditor by the Secretary of the Senate.

Chapter 183.

Resolve, on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Pay Roll of the House of Representatives. Resolved That there be paid to the members and officers of the House of Representatives of the Seventy-ninth Legislature, for attendance and mileage at the special session of the Legislature convened on the thirty-first day of August, nineteen hundred twenty, the amounts stated opposite their respective names on a Pay Roll list certified to the State Auditor by the Clerk of the House.
