CHAP, 51

#### Chapter 51.

An Act to Amend Section Forty-three of Chapter Two of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Appointment of Dedimus Justices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 2, § 43; relating to the appointment of qualifying officers, amended. Section forty-three of chapter two of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "persons" in the second line thereof the words, 'who shall be designated as dedimus justices'; so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:
- 'Sec. 43. Providing that they be designated dedimus justices. The governor, with the advice and consent of the council, may appoint in every county, persons who shall be designated as dedimus justices, before whom the oath, required by the constitution to qualify civil officers, may be taken and subscribed. Such persons shall exercise their powers and duties, and shall be commissioned to act within and for every county. This section shall apply to such persons appointed and commissioned prior to the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and eleven, and shall validate any acts theretofore or thereafter done by them which would be valid hereunder.

#### Chapter 52.

An Act to Amend Section Thirty-seven of Chapter Twenty-four of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Appropriation for the Abolishment of Grade Crossings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 24, § 37; relating to the appropriation for the abolishment or alteration of grade crossings, amended. Section thirty-seven of chapter twenty-four of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "year" in the second line thereof the words, 'except as herein provided,' by striking out in the second line the word "fifteen" and inserting in place thereof the word 'ten,' and by adding at the end of said section the following paragraph:

'The amounts to be appropriated under the provisions of this section shall be cumulative and any part of said sum of ten thousand dollars not expended during the year for which it is appropriated shall, at the close of said year, be added to the sums subsequently appropriated, and may be expended in any subsequent year or years'; so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 37. Limit of appropriation decreased from \$15,000 to \$10,000, except as otherwise specifically provided; appropriation to be a
