be subject to all the conditions, regulations and requirements of sections three, four, seven, and eight of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes.

'Sec. 6. County commissioners to prescribe rules and regulations, not inconsistent with law. The county commissioners of Hancock county shall have authority, on due notice and hearing of all parties interested, to prescribe such rules and regulations, touching the maintenance and operation of said ferry not otherwise provided in nor inconsistent with sections one, two, three and four of said chapter twenty, as they may deem necessary to meet the public demand in connection therewith.'

Chapter 91.

An Act to Amend Chapter Three Hundred and Fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred and Eighty-three, Relating to the Construction of a Bridge over Tidewaters between Orr's Island and Bailey's Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1883, c. 356, § 1; authorizing the construction of a bridge over tide water between Orr's Island and Bailey's Island in the town of Harpswell, amended. Section one of chapter three hundred fifty-six of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred eighty-three relating to the construction of a bridge over tide waters between Orr's Island and Bailey's Island is hereby amended so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Bridge may be constructed with or without a draw as may be required by U. S. War Department. Authority is hereby given to lay out, construct and maintain a bridge, with or without a draw, as may be required by the United States War Department, across and over the tidewaters separating Orr's Island from Bailey's Island in the Town of Harpswell.'
