CHAP. 23

Chapter 23.

Resolve, for the Laying of the County Taxes for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-two.

County taxes, 1922. Resolved: That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes of law, for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-two: Androscoggin, eighty-six thousand six hundred dollars \$86,600.00 Aroostook, eighty thousand seven hundred and sixty dollars, 80,760.00 Cumberland, two hundred and one thousand four hundred and one dollars 201,401.00 Franklin, twenty-five thousand nine hundred dollars 25,900.00Hancock, thirty-six thousand three hundred and twelve dollars 36,312.00 Kennebec, sixty-six thousand dollars 66,000.00 Knox, thirty-two thousand dollars 32,000.00 Lincoln, fourteen thousand five hundred dollars, 14,500.00**Oxford**, fifty thousand dollars 50,000.00 Penobscot, one hundred thousand seven hundred dollars 100,700.00 **Piscataguis**, thirty thousand dollars 30,000.00 Sagadahoc, thirty thousand dollars 30,000.00 Somerset, fifty-eight thousand two hundred fifty dollars 58,250.00 Waldo, fifty thousand five hundred and twelve dollars 50,512.00 Washington, sixty-six thousand dollars 66,000.00 York, eighty-seven thousand five hundred dollars 87,500.00 Approved March 26, 1921.

Chapter 24.

Resolve, for Laying the County Taxes for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the appropriations called for in this resolve are immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
