health and safety, and in the opinion of this legislature constitute an emergency as contemplated by the constitution, be it therefore

**Resolved: County taxes, 1921.** That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes of law, for the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one:

<b>Somerset</b> , fifty-eight thousand two hundred fifty dollars	58,250.00

## Chapter 25.

Resolve, Appropriating Money to Reimburse the Inhabitants of the Town of Island Falls for Money Paid to Levi H. May.

**Island Falls, damages to domestic animals. Resolved:** That the sum of four hundred and thirty-seven dollars and twenty cents be,

and hereby is, appropriated out of the moneys received by the state under chapter four, sections one hundred and one to one hundred and three of the revised statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen, to be paid to the treasurer of the Town of Island Falls, to reimburse said town for money paid Levi H. May for damages done to the domestic animals of said May by wild animals during the years nineteen hundred and seventeen and nineteen hundred and eighteen.

## Chapter 26.

Resolve, in Favor of Commissioner of Labor and Industry and State Factory Inspector for Bonus as Head of a State Department.

**Roscoe A. Eddy, bonus in accordance with chap. 255, p. 1. 1919.**

**Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of thirteen hundred thirty-three dollars and thirty-three cents to be paid Roscoe A. Eddy, commissioner of labor and industry and state factory inspector, as the bonus due him as head of a state department for the years nineteen hundred nineteen and nineteen hundred twenty, in accordance with chapter two hundred fifty-five of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, passed at the special session in November, nineteen hundred and nineteen.

## Chapter 27.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for Further Maintenance of the State Forest Nursery.

**State Forest Nursery, further maintenance. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars; one thousand dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, and one thousand dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, to be expended by the forest commissioner for the maintenance of the state forest nursery or for establishing auxiliary nurseries and for encouraging in any practical way the reforestation of waste or cut over timberland in the State of Maine.

## Chapter 28.

Resolve, Appropriating Money for General Forestry Purposes.

**General Forestry Purposes. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of twenty thousand dollars; ten thousand dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-
