### Chapter 63.

Resolve, in Favor of Meldon Nealley for State Pension.

Meldon Nealley, state pension. Resolved: That there be paid to Meldon Nealley of Brewer the sum of twelve dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred twenty-one, and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature; which said payment shall be in lieu of payment under chapter two hundred fourteen of the resolves of nineteen hundred fifteen, and payment under said chapter shall be discontinued.

### Chapter 64.

Resolve, Increasing the State Pension of Vinnie E. Saunders of Trescott.

Vinnie E. Saunders, increasing state pension. Resolved: That the pension of fifteen dollars per month granted to Vinnie E. Saunders, under the provisions of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventeen, be increased to twenty dollars per month, commencing January one, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, until further order of the legislature.

Approved April 5, 1921.

### Chapter 65.

Resolve, in Favor of Catherine Nelligan of Brewer for State Pension,

Catherine Nelligan, state pension. Resolved: That there be paid to Catherine Nelligan of Brewer the sum of ten dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for soldiers' pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature; which said payment shall be in lieu of payment under chapter eighty-six of the resolves of nineteen hundred nineteen, and payment under said chapter shall be discontinued.

#### Chapter 66.

Resolve, Providing for Payment for the Care of Pearl Clark, During the Year of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen.

Orono, care of neglected children. Resolved: That there be paid to the Town of Orono, from the nineteen hundred and twenty-one appropriation for care and board of neglected children, the sum of twenty-seven dollars and sixty-six cents to reimburse said Town of Orono for money expended for the care of Pearl Clark during the year nineteen hundred and
