Chapter 83.

Resolve, in Favor of the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the fiscal year of the State of Maine now ends on June thirtieth instead of January first, and no money is available under a regular appropriation for the first six months of the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and whereas the appropriation for the first six months in nineteen hundred and twenty-one for the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore,

Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum, maintenance. Resolved: That there be paid to the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum for maintenance, nine thousand two hundred seventy-five dollars for the period from January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one; eighteen thousand five hundred fifty dollars for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two; eighteen thousand five hundred fifty dollars for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three. That there be paid for personal services in the aforementioned institution, three thousand one hundred dollars for the period from January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one; six thousand two hundred dollars for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two; six thousand two hundred dollars for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
