CHAP. 90

and twenty-one, sixty-six dollars for the fiscal year of nineteen hundred and twenty-two, and sixty-six dollars for the fiscal year of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, be, and is hereby appropriated, for payment of outstanding claims for extra pay for the Maine Volunteers in the war with Spain.

Chapter 90.

Resolve, to Amend a Resolve Providing for Aid in the Payment of Premiums Awarded by the Eastern Maine State Fair.

Res. 1919, c. 122, relating to aid in payment of premiums at Eastern Maine State Fair, amended. Resolved: That chapter one hundred and twenty-two of the resolves of nineteen hundred and nineteen is hereby amended by striking out the words "one thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars" in the second and third lines of said chapter and inserting in place thereof the words, 'two thousand five hundred dollars,' so that said chapter, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Resolved: That there be annually appropriated the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars for the Eastern Maine State Fair, provided that the said society shall annually appropriate and award an amount equal to the sum hereby appropriated, and pay the same in premiums for stock, dairy, agricultural and industrial products. Said society may draw said appropriation upon its vouchers that such amount has been paid out for strictly stock, dairy, agricultural and industrial purposes.'

Res. 1889, chap. 160, repealed. Chapter one hundred and sixty, of the resolves of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine is hereby repealed.

Chapter 91.

Resolve, in Favor of the State School for Girls, for Maintenance and Other Purposes.

State School for Girls, maintenance. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for maintenance of the State School for Girls, the following sums:

For personal services, namely, salaries and wages of all officers and employees except those wholly engaged in repairs of buildings and equipment; for the first fiscal period, January first to June thirtieth inclusive in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of nine thousand six hundred and forty-six dollars and thirty-two cents,

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
