CHAP. 98

Aroostook Farm.

For continuing at Aroostook Farm the scientific investigations provided for in section one, chapter four, private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen: For the period January one, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars; for the year July one, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the sum of five thousand dollars; and for the year July one, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, the sum of five thousand dollars.

Chapter 98.

Resolve, in Favor of Horace Nelson, Representative of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Horace Nelson, representative Penobscot Indians 80th legislature. Resolved: That there be appropriated and paid to Horace Nelson, representative of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians at the eightieth session of the legislature, one hundred and sixty-five dollars for attendance and eighteen dollars for mileage.

Chapter 99.

Resolve, in Favor of the Maine General Hospital.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the fiscal year of the State of Maine now ends on June 30th instead of January 1st, and no money is available under a regular appropriation for the first six months of the year 1921, and whereas, the appropriation for the first six months of the year 1921 for the Maine General Hospital is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore,

Grading grounds. Resolved: That there be appropriated for grading the grounds of the Maine General Hospital for the period from January 1st, 1921, to June 30th, 1921, the sum of five hundred dollars, and for the period from July 1st, 1921, to June 30th, 1922, the sum of five hundred dollars. The above amounts are to be expended under direction of George F. Kavanough, Arthur F. Moulton and Fred J. Harrigan, all of Portland.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
