Chapter 100.

Resolve, in Favor of the Northern Maine Sanatorium, Presque Isle, Aroostook County.

Emergency preamble. Whereas the change in the fiscal year, made by statute in 1919, leaves the six months from January 1, 1921 to June 30, 1921, a period for which an appropriation to be available, must be made as an emergency and, whereas, the appropriation of money for the said six months is an emergency measure and is necessary for the public peace, health and safety, now therefore,

Northern Maine Sanatorium personal services and maintenance. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the Northern Maine Sanatorium:

Personal Services Jan. 1, 1921-June 30, 1923.

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages of all officers and employees except those wholly engaged in repairs of buildings and equipment, the sum of \$6500 for the period from January 1, 1921 to June 30, 1921; the sum of \$13,000 from July 1, 1921 to June 30, 1922; and the sum of \$13,000 from July 1, 1922 to June 30, 1923.

Maintenance, Jan. 1, 1921-June 30, 1923.

For maintenance; namely all articles of food and all other materials, supplies and expenses incident to maintenance of the institution and the patients thereof, whether present or absent, the sum of \$6,654.38 for the period from January 1, 1921 to June 30, 1921; the sum of \$13,308.75 for the period from July 1, 1921 to June 30, 1922; and the sum of \$13,308.75 for the period from July 1, 1922 to June 30, 1923.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 101.

Resolve, in Favor of Wallace Lewey, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Wallace Lewey, representative Passamaquoddy Indians, 80th legislature. Resolved: That there be appropriated and paid to Wallace Lewey, representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians at the eightieth session of the legislature, one hundred sixty-five dollars for attendance and forty-two dollars for mileage.
