Chapter 128.

Resolve, in Favor of the State School for Boys for Maintenance and Other Purposes.

State School for Boys, maintenance and other purposes. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for maintenance of the State School for Boys, the following sums:

For personal services, namely, salaries and wages of all officers and employees, except those wholly engaged in repairs and construction of buildings and equipment:	
For the fiscal period January first to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of ten thousand dollars,	\$10,000.00
For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the sum of twenty thousand dollars, For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred	20,000.00
and twenty-three, the sum of twenty thousand dollars,	20,000.00
For maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs, replacements, equipment, and for general expenses: For the fiscal period January first to June thirtieth, nineteen hun- dred and twenty-one, the sum of twenty-four thousand and seventy-five dollars,	24,075.00
For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, the sum of forty-eight thousand one hundred and fifty dollars,	48,150.00

CHAP. 129,

Emergency. Whereas, the appropriations specified in this resolve, applying to the first fiscal period named herein, are immediately necessary for the continued operation of this institution and thereby make this an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore, be it

Resolved, that this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 129.

Resolve, in Favor of the Western Maine Sanatorium.

Emergency preamble. Whereas no regular appropriation is available until ninety days after the adjournment of the legislature making the same, and

Whereas funds are necessary for personal services at and maintenance of the Western Maine Sanatorium, or the said sanatorium will have to be closed, and

Whereas the need for the maintenance of said sanatorium is an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore

Western Maine Sanatorium, personal services, maintenance and repairs. Resolved: That there be and there hereby is appropriated for the Western Maine Sanatorium:

For personal services for the fiscal period from January first to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, the sum of twenty thousand dollars.	\$20,000.00
For maintenance during said fiscal period, the sum of fifty- seven thousand one hundred dollars.	57,100.00
Personal services, for the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, for personal services the sum of forty thousand dollars.	40,000.004
For maintenance, repairs and improvements for said second fiscal period, the sum of one hundred fourteen thousand and five hundred dollars.	114,500.00
Personal services, for the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, for personal services the sum of forty thousand dollars.	40,000.00

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
