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## Chapter 159.

Resolve, Making Appropriations for the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians for the Half Year from January First, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, to June Thirtieth, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, and the Years July First, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, to June Thirtieth, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-three.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, the State of Maine holds in trust for the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians a certain large sum of money, to wit: one hundred nine thousand ninety-four dollars and fifty cents, and whereas all funds appropriated by the seventy-ninth legislature for the care, maintenance and relief of said tribe have been expended for the purposes and in the manner prescribed by law, and because of the lack of available funds, said tribe may fall into distress and be deprived of proper food, shelter and clothing, and,

Whereas, by reason of the foregoing facts the appropriation called for in this resolve is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and in the opinion of this legislature constitutes an emergency as contemplated in the constitution, be it therefore

**Passamaquoddy Indians, care and maintenance. Resolved:** That there be paid from the state treasury, to be expended under the direction of the governor and council, to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for the benefit of said tribe for the period from January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-one, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, as follows:

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

## Chapter 160.

Resolve, To Apportion One Hundred and Fifty-one Representatives among the Several Counties, Cities, Towns, Plantations and Classes in the State of Maine.

**Apportionment of representatives to the legislature. Resolved:** That for the eighty-first legislature to and including that of the year nineteen hundred and thirty-one:

**The County of Androscoggin shall choose thirteen representatives** to be apportioned as follows: Auburn, three representatives; Lewiston, five representatives; Lisbon, one representative; East Livermore and
