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# Chapter 3.

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Fish and Game. Non-resident fishing license. P. L. 1921, Chap. 57, § 1, amended.

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# Chapter 210.

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# Chapter 211.

Motor Vehicles and law of the road. An act to revise and amend also additional to existing laws relative to same. R. S. Chap. 26 repealed. All existing motor vehicle law repealed.

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State Highway Commission. Providing for a full time commission. Salary fixed. R. S. Chap. 25, §§ 3 and 4, amended. R. S. Chap. 117, § 34, amended.

## Chapter 214.

Eliot Bridge. Authorizing Highway Commission to receive a conveyance of that part of the toll bridge between South Berwick, Maine, and Dover, N. H., that lies in the State of Maine, and to maintain it as a public highway. New provision.

#### Chapter 215.

State Highway Commission. Authority given to remove obstructions from highways. R. S. Chap. 25, § 6, amended. Municipal officers given same authority. R. S. Chap. 24, § 104, amended.

## Chapter 216.

Memorial Day. Prohibiting public games and sports on. New provision.

#### Chapter 217.

Military law. Staff of Commander-in-Chief. Duties of inspector general. Inspections. Promotions. Examination and qualifications of officers. Enlistment period. Pay. P. L. 1917, Chap. 259, amended.

## Chapter 218.

Fish and Game. Authority of wardens increased. Certain implements and devices prohibited. Cusk fishing regulated. Permits to take alewives. Closed time on fur bearing animals. Traps to be labeled, and snares, set guns, etc. prohibited. Permits to import game. Penalty for violations. Wardens may sell game seized. P. L. 1917, Chap. 219, and P. L. 1919, Chap. 196, amended.

# Chapter 219.

County officers. Salaries increased. Clerk hire in county offices apportioned. R. S. Chap. 117, § § 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, and 45, amended.

# Chapter 220.

Highways. Second and third class state highways. Maintenance of. P. L. 1919, Chap. 263, § 7, amended.

## Chapter 221.

Sinking fund. Created to provide for war bonds and bonus bonds. New provision.

## Chapter 222.

Workmen's compensation. Clerical errors corrected. Time when compensation commences changed. Amount of compensation increased. Associate legal member to act when office of chairman is vacant. Compensation agreements to be approved. Where hearings shall be held, and expenses of same, how paid. P. L. 1919, Chap. 238, §§ 1, 7, 9, 12, 14, 15, 16, 26, 29, 30, and 33, amended.

## Chapter 223.

Dogs and wild animals. Damage done by to domestic animals. Damage to poultry not included. R. S. Chap. 4, § 110, amended.

#### Chapter 224.

Corporations. Formation of having stock without par value. R. S. Chap. 51, §§ 115, 116, 117, 118, 119, as enacted by P. L. 1917, Chap. 144, amended by striking out and substituting new sections therefor.
